

## **Information Regarding Learning Differences**

In order for your son/daughter to receive learning accommodations, he/she must have an updated (within 3 years) learning evaluation on file in the Counseling Office. This evaluation must be conducted by a certified psychologist. Accommodations may include, but are not limited to, extended time on tests, preferential seating and use of oral exams.

Please note that your son/daughter's evaluation *must be submitted to and approved through The College Board* if he/she is to receive special accommodations on their PSAT, SAT or AP exams. The SSD Coordinator works closely with The College Board to help streamline this submission process.

All confidential documentation is kept in the student's file in the Counseling Office. Teachers and counselors have access to this information. The information is not released to colleges and will be destroyed upon the student's graduation or withdrawal from the school.
