Dinner to Support a St. Elizabeth Scholarship

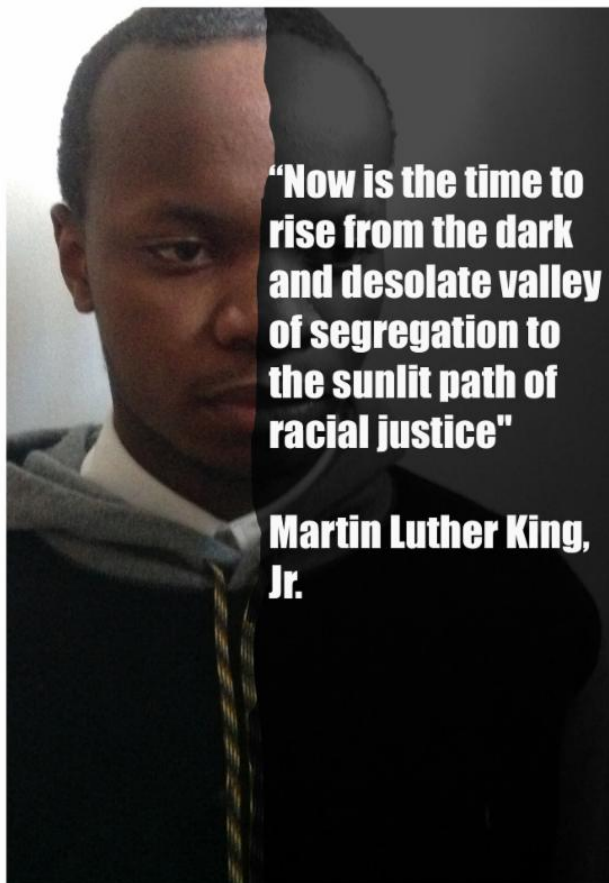
