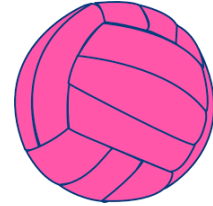

Red dress down day to Support Firefighters

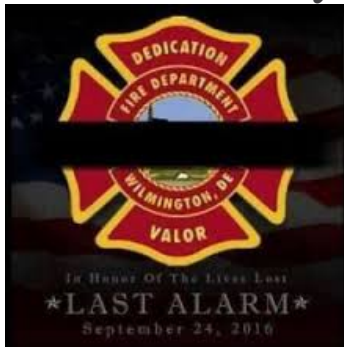

College Visit Day

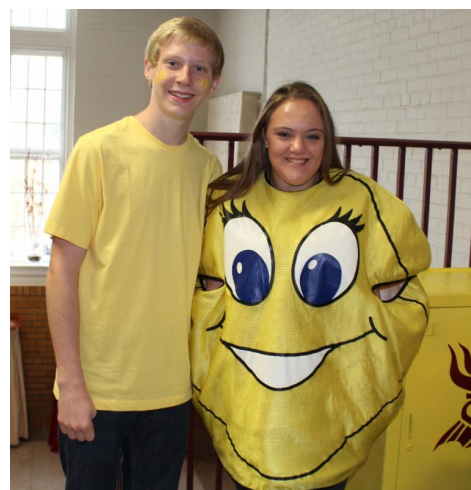
Due to PSAT testing for grades 9-11, Wednesday is a day for seniors to visit colleges. Seniors should not report to school.
