For the month of October, the school store will be open on Mondays and Wednesdays after school until 4pm except on Oct. 24th, when it will not be open.

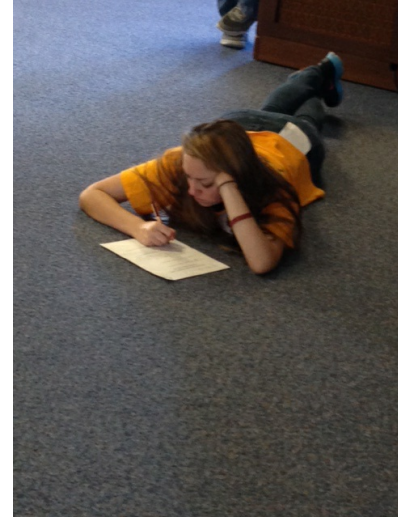
