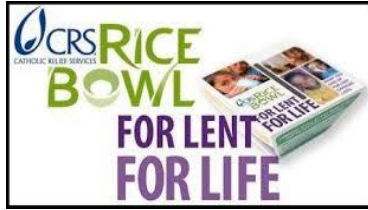
Blue-Gold All-Star Basketball Game

Offutt Offered Peak Award

Junior Rita Offutt received the newly established Peak Award presented by the Delaware Theatre Company to honor the memory of former DTC member Danny Peak. Rita was lauded for being an active collaborator in the workshop process of the Delaware Young Playwrights Festival where she offered constructive feedback in an encouraging way about others' work, asked questions about her own work, and graciously accepted the perspectives of the other playwrights and theatre artists. Her play *Dear Daddy* was given the Realism Award for exploration of issues facing our society today. In the words of Johanna Schloss, Associate Director of Education and Community Engagement at DTC, "This playwright courageously took on the sensitive topics of race and community relations between citizens and police as viewed through the lens of two teenage girls who love their fathers." Rita's work was praised for its use of believable, realistic dialogue which was said to augment the element of honesty found in the play.
